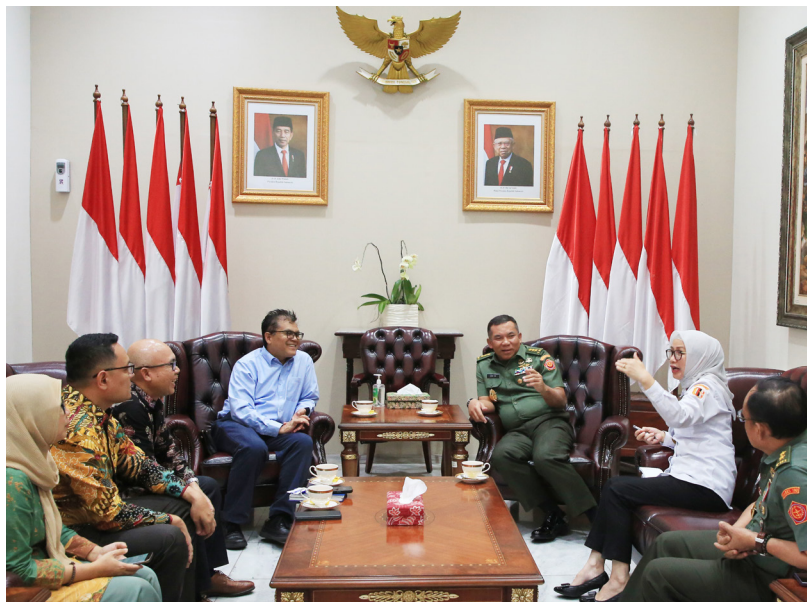

## RTD on Taiwan Potential Conflict Scenario

**JAKARTA** - The Directorate of Ideological and Political Studies of Lemhannas RI held a Round Table Discussion (RTD) with the topic "Taiwan's Potential Conflict Scenario and Mitigation for Indonesia", on Wednesday (7/8). The discussion, which was conducted at the Kresna Room, was directly chaired by the Deputy for Strategic Studies, Prof. Dr. Ir. Reni Mayerni, M.P.

In her remarks, Reni Mayerni mentioned the Economist Intelligence Unit's report "Risk Outlook 2024: Ten Critical Risk Scenarios Facing the Global Economy," indicating China's potential military annexation of Taiwan, which could potentially cause a massive threat. In addition, President Xi Jinping's statement on Taiwan's reunification also intensified the urgency for Indonesia to explore and mitigate the possible risks. "Indonesia, being geographically located close to the Taiwan Strait, should be concerned about the impact of existing scenarios, including the status quo scenario, peaceful reunification, and armed conflict," Reni Mayerni said.

To anticipate the potential risks, Lemhannas RI has conducted a series of events, including Focus Group Discussion (FGD) and data collection from multiple locus to develop comprehensive policy recommendations. The event, which was facilitated by Lemhannas RI's Professional Expert of International Relations and Diplomacy, Edy Prasetyono, S.Sos., M.I.S., Ph.D, aimed to prepare Indonesia to face all the possibilities that might arise in the Taiwan Strait.

This RTD presented several sources, including the Secretary Directorate General of Defense Strategy MoD, Brigadier General Dr. Oktaheroe Ramsi, S.I.P., M.Sc; Expert Staff Officer Tk.III for Polkamnas of the TNI Commander, Major General (Mar) Siswoto, M.Tr. Opsla; Deputy for Coordination of International Economic Cooperation at the Coordinating Ministry for Economic Affairs, Raden Edi Prio Pambudi; Director of Defense and Security of the Deputy for Political,

Legal and Security Affairs of the Ministry of National Development Planning/National Development Planning Agency, Erik Armundito, S.T., M.T., Ph.D; Head of the Planning and Cooperation Bureau of the National Border Management Agency at the Ministry of Home Affairs, Dra. Farida Kurnianingrum, M.M., and Head of the International Relations Postgraduate Study Program of the University of Indonesia, Broto Wardoyo, Ph.D.

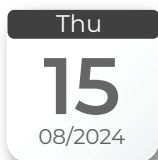

## Deputy Minister of Communication and Information: Digital Transformation Changes Business Processes and Organizations



**JAKARTA** -"Everything is changing as Indonesian people become increasingly connected through digital technology. People behaviours, ways of absorbing information, life, and even social relationships change," said Deputy Minister of Communication and Information of the Republic of Indonesia (Wamen Kominfo RI) Nezar Patria during his lecture to Regular Education Program Batch 67 (PPRA 67) of 2024 of Lemhannas RI at the Bhinneka Tunggal Ika Room, Thursday (15/8).

Nezar Patria further explained that digital transformation causes digital adoption which change business and organizational processes. As an important aspect in digital transformation, national resilience must be able to carry out three main functions, namely deterring digital integrity, directing cyber potential, and unifying mindsets.

Since the last 10 years, the digital transformation process has continued

to be echoed. A commitment to create a road map that accompanies us towards a Golden Indonesia to guide the digital transformation process has been prepared. However, the digital transformation process is challenging. Some challenges include the digital divide, cyber threats, and the need for digital talent. Therefore, these challenges must be assisted by increased cyber security, rapid response to cyber threats, and increased intelligence capabilities.

Concluding his lecture, Nezar Patria said that in adopting digital resilience technology, there are various digital technologies for the defense sector in the future that need to be developed. This digital technology consists of Self-Flying Drone Technology, AI-Based Video Monitoring, Internet of Things Sensors for Security, Quantum Computing for Data Encryption, as well as Augmented Reality (AR) and Virtual Reality (VR). "All technology has unexpected consequences, so the most important thing is that we all understand what is happening globally," concluded the Deputy Minister of Communication and Information of the Republic of Indonesia.

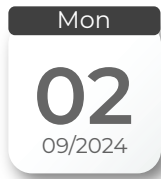
In the closing ceremony, Acting Governor awarded the best academic score predicate to Police Grand Commissioner Jefri Ronald
