Professional Experts of Lemhannas RI Discuss IMF-Indonesia Report





JAKARTA - Several Professional Experts of Lemhannas RI attended an Intellectual Exercise Sharing Session with the theme "Review of IMF-Indonesia Report" at Syailendra Room on Wednesday (30/10). The event invited the Senior Director of Bank Indonesia, Haris Munandar, to discuss "Indonesian Economy from the Lens of 2024 IMF Article IV Consultation Report".

The Senior Director of Bank Indonesia stated that the IMF considered Indonesia's economic growth to remain resilient with maintained inflation and a robust financial sector. The IMF envisions Indonesia's economic performance to remain high, growing at 5.0% and 5.1% in 2024 and 2025, respectively. However, Indonesia must maintain prudent fiscal policy, reform to protect financial sector resilience, and bridge structural gaps to achieve the Golden Indonesia of 2045.

On this occasion, the governor of Lemhannas RI, Dr. H. TB. Ace Hasan Syadzily, M.Si., stated that the meeting was urgently needed because the Professional Expert's perspectives on economic resilience are essential to provide strategic insights to the President.

Furthermore, Ace Hasan Syadzily mentioned that one of the

government's targets is to achieve economic growth of up to 8%. Lemhannas RI is expected to provide support by preparing a scenario outlining the steps to realize this.

Therefore, the governor of Lemhannas RI emphasized the vital role of Lemhannas RI's professional experts in drafting a scenario regarding these issues. "I hope you all can comprehensively understand the economic development conditions that will inevitably affect our domestic economic situation," he concluded.

Lemhannas RI Planning Bureau **Conducts Socialization on Service Standards**

JAKARTA - The National Resilience Institute of the Republic of Indonesia conducted the Socialization on Organizational and Governance Policies (Socialization on Service Standards) that was delivered by the Ministry of Administrative and Bureaucratic Reform (PANRB) of the Republic of Indonesia on Tuesday (5/11) online. The event was opened directly by the Head of the Planning Bureau of Lemhannas RI, Commodore Trismawan Djonisajoko, S.E., M.M., M.Tr.Opsla.

The most important aspect of service standards is policy. "The highest level of policy is the president who wishes for the citizens to receive the best excellent service." Trismawan stated in his speech. Following this, legislation will be created to regulate policies on service standards.

Trismawan hopes that with the socialization of service standards based on policies, regulations, and legislation, all personnel can understand and implement them properly. The standards regulate the service providers and the public by ensuring that they understand their rights and the extent to which they are served. He explained that the purpose of excellent service is to make the public satisfied, accepted, and served well. "Hopefully this socialization can encourage public servants to have a better sense of service," he stressed.

The socialization featured a Policy Analyst from the Deputy Office of Public Services of the Ministry of

PANRB, Lies Woro Susanti, as a speaker. On this occasion, Lies Woro explained the Guidelines for Service Standards based on the Minister of PANRB Regulation Number 15 of 2014. In her speech, Lies Woro emphasized that service standards

have six principles, namely simplicity, participative, accountability, sustainability, transparency, and fairness. After the presentation. the socialization continued with questions and answers session.









Lemhannas RI Studies the Geopolitical Dynamics of the Middle East

JAKARTA - To explore the crucial issues growing in the Middle East region and its impact on national interests, Lemhannas RI held a Focus Group Discussion (FGD) on "Geopolitical Dynamics in the Middle East and its Impact on Indonesia" at Kresna Room, Astagatra Building, Lemhannas RI on Wednesday (6/11).

The Deputy for Strategic Studies of Lemhannas RI, Prof. Dr. Ir. Reni Mayerni, M.P., stated that in terms of the global economy, the escalation of conflict in the Middle East raises concerns about the stability of the world oil price, which has a direct impact on global economic conditions, including Indonesia. "As a state with a high level of energy dependence, Indonesia must be

concerned about the fluctuations in oil prices caused by this conflict," the Deputy for Strategic Studies of Lemhannas RI remarked.

Oil price fluctuations caused by conflicts in the Middle East can increase the burden on the state budget and affect the prices of goods and services in the domestic market. Meanwhile, regarding national security, the geopolitical dynamics in the Middle East can lead to more significant risks, like the rise of terrorism.

The discussion group is expected to produce policy recommendations to anticipate the impacts of the Middle East conflict on Indonesia. "Hopefully, this discussion can become an initial and significant

effort to prepare Indonesia to face the challenging geopolitical dynamics of the Middle East," the Deputy for Strategic Studies of Lemhannas RI stated.

Attending the event as speakers were a Professor at the Faculty of Humanities of the University of Indonesia and Head of the Middle East and Islamic Studies Program, Prof. Yon Machmudi, Ph.D.; Lecturer at the Department of International Relations of University of Indonesia, Agung Nurwijoyo, M.Sc.; Researcher at the Department of International Relations of the Center for Strategic and International Studies (CSIS), Pieter Pandie; Director of the Middle East at the Directorate General of Asia Pacific and Africa of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ahrul Tsani Fathurrahman; and Head of the Terrorism Studies Program at the School of Strategic and Global Studies of University of Indonesia, M. Syauqillah, S.H.I., M.Si., Ph.D.



Asta Cita as Lemhannas RI's Guidance in Performing its Duties

JAKARTA - "Superman is not that great, but superteam is great. That if we collaborate well with one another. Third, the Deputy Office for Strengthening of National Values must design and implement strengthening of national values programs as an effort to nurture national ideology.

Fourth, the National Resilience
Measurement Laboratory must
promptly improve and evaluate the
methodology and data collection
mechanism required to produce
the national resilience index
measurement. Fifth, Lemhannas
RI must immediately prepare a
strategic plan document for the next
five years as an elaboration of the
National Medium-Term Development
Plan (RPJMN) of 2025-2029.

"Let's eliminate sectoral egos. We all stand in the same direction, so there will be no unhealthy competition when developing Lemhannas RI," the governor of Lemhannas RI concluded.

Governor Presents Lemhannas RI's 100-Day-Work-Plan at the Hearing Meeting

JAKARTA - Lemhannas RI attended the Lemhannas RI Hearing Meeting (RDP) with Commission I DPR RI at the Commission I Meeting Room DPR RI on Wednesday (13/11). On this occasion, the Governor of Lemhannas RI Dr. H. TB. Ace Hasan Syadzily, M.Si was accompanied by a number of Lemhannas RI leaders, including the Main Secretary of Lemhannas RI, Komjen Pol. Drs. R. Z. Panca Putra S., M.Si., Deputies, Directors and Bureau Heads of Lemhannas RI.

The agenda for the RDP is to explain Lemhannas RI's 100-day work plan, Lemhannas RI's strategic study regarding national, regional and international geopolitical dynamics, as well as the situation and conditions of Indonesia's national

resilience ahead of the 2024 regional elections.

Regarding Lemhannas RI's 100 working day plan, the Governor of Lemhannas RI stated that the plan was divided into seven structures. First, Lemhannas RI will start providing education for prospective national leaders in January 2025 with the theme "Accelerating Inclusive and Sustainable Economic Growth" which is adapted to the theme of the 2025 RKP. Second, Lemhannas RI is also conducting studies related to current issues which will start in November 2024.

Third, Lemhannas RI will organize and prepare an evaluation of the assessment methodology by raising the topic of strengthening Indonesia's economic diplomacy to the national strategy for poverty alleviation. Fourth, Lemhannas RI will start implementing structured strengthening of national values by educating trainers and facilitators through a training program for trainers. Apart from that, Lemhannas RI will implement the Lemhannas goes to Campus Program which targets the younger generation. The fifth work plan structure is to measure the national resilience index through structuring methodology, data measurement mechanisms and variable indicators for measuring the national resilience index. Finally, Lemhannas RI will carry out institutional strengthening by updating regulations by improving Presidential Decree 98 of 2016 concerning Lemhannas RI and reproposing a national resilience law.
