Lemhannas RI Supports Nutritious Food Policy Through Food Self-Sufficiency

JAKARTA - The government announced a priority program to achieve food self-sufficiency and transform Indonesia to become the world's food barn following the 2nd Asta Cita to achieve food resilience. Concerning this program, Lemhannas RI organized a Focus Group Discussion (FGD) on "Food Resilience: Towards Food Self-Sufficiency and World Food Barn" on Tuesday (3/12) at Kresna Room, Astagatra Building, Lemhannas RI.

During the opening, Vice Governor of Lemhannas RI, Lieut, Gen, Eko Margiyono, stated that food and energy resilience have become strategic issues to realize the nation's self-reliance. "The increasing needs due to population growth bring complex challenges to secure access to sufficient, safe, and nutritious food," he said.

The issues are aggravated by the difficulties in preparing land, including access, ownership, and the suitability of land conditions to the program. The poor ratio of agricultural equipment compared to Indonesia's

total area also complicates the efficient land management process. To resolve these challenges, Lemhannas RI is committed to providing holistic and applicable policy recommendations to the president.

Attending the event as speakers were Director of PT Datu Nusra Agrobisnis (DNA), Dean Novel; Special Staff of KASAD, Brigadier General Wirana Prasetya Budi, SE; President Director of Bank DKI, Agus Harvoto Widodo; Operational Director of PT Multi Andalan Sejati Muhammad, Angga Rifandi Pane: President Director of PT Food Station Tiipinang Jaya, Karyawan Gunarso; and Agriculture Analyst, Khudori.

The diverse backgrounds of the speakers will hopefully enable them to generate cross-sectoral collaboration and formulate policy recommendations as a reference for decision-making in accelerating the realization of national food self-sufficiency and a resilient and sustainable world food barn.

JAKARTA - The Directorate of Economic and Natural Resources Studies (SKA) of Lemhannas RI organized a Focus Group Discussion (FGD) with the title "BRICS Cooperation and Post-Election US Policies and Its Impact on Indonesia" at Kresna Room, on Wednesday (4/12). The event was presided over by the Governor of Lemhannas RI, Dr. H. TB. Ace Hasan Syadzily, M. Si.

In his speech, the governor of Lemhannas RI stated that national economic resilience is currently facing several challenges, including geopolitical instability and financial market volatility. Global geopolitical tensions due to the trade war between the United States and China and the war between Russia and Ukraine have greatly affected global economic stability in many countries, including Indonesia. "Collaboration with international economic organizations, such as BRICS, can provide the necessary framework to address these challenges," he remarked.

Lemhannas RI must discuss policies formulated by the President of the Republic of Indonesia to take proper measures. Indonesia's National Resilience is in **Quite Resilient Condition**

JAKARTA - "The overall national resilience index is at a score of 2.87 with quite resilient conditions," said the Governor of Lemhannas RI Dr. H. TB. Ace Hasan Syadzily, M.Sc. This statement was conveyed in the Press Conference "End-Year-Reflection and Release of 2024 and 2025 Outlook" of Lemhannas RI at Konstitusi Room on Monday (23/12).

This score is the result of measurements carried out by the National Resilience Measurement Laboratory (Labkurtannas) of Lemhannas RI which is based on eight aspects (gatra). The eight aspects consist of Geography with a score of 2.66, Demography with a score of 3.20, Natural Resources with a score of 2.91, Ideology with a score of 2.78, Politics with a score of

2.83, Economy with a score of 3.08, Defense and Security with a score of 3.02, and Social Culture with a score of 2.55. A total of seven aspects are in a fairly strong position, except for the socio-cultural aspect.

The results of the national resilience index measurement is used to evaluate the achievements of ongoing national development programs and a guide for future development planning. Therefore, Indonesia should not be satisfied with the results of this index.

Lemhannas RI believes the national resilience index needs to be improved to strengthen national resilience. This can be realized if it is supported by collaboration among stakeholders to create an

advanced Indonesia that is sovereign, independent and based in mutual support.
