JAKARTA - The National Resilience Institute of the Republic of Indonesia (Lemhannas RI) and the Ministry for the Protection of Indonesian Migrant Workers (KP2MI) signed a memorandum of understanding at the Konstitusi Room of the Trigatra Building on Tuesday (5/5). The partnership marks a strategic step toward strengthening human resource development, conducting strategic studies, and instilling national values among Indonesian migrant workers.

Governor of Lemhannas RI Dr. H. TB. Ace Hasan Syadzily, M.Si., said the cooperation reflected both institutions' commitment to support the achievement of national goals by implementing their respective mandates and functions.

"This initiative represents the shared commitment of Lemhannas RI and KP2MI to build collaboration through various joint programs and activities in accordance with our respective duties and functions, with the aim of

achieving national objectives and supporting government programs," Ace said in his opening remarks.

As a follow-up to the agreement, one of the first programs to be implemented will be a pre-departure orientation for Indonesian migrant workers before they are placed overseas. Through this cooperation, Lemhannas RI and KP2MI reaffirmed their commitment to enhance the capacity and national awareness of Indonesian migrant workers, enabling them to become positive representatives of the nation while contributing to the advancement of Indonesia's national interests at the global level.

JAKARTA - The National Resilience Institute of the Republic of Indonesia (Lemhannas RI), in collaboration with the Corruption Eradication Commission (KPK), held an Integrity and Anti-Corruption Strengthening Program for 84 participants of the Consolidation Program for National-level Leaders (P3N) Batch 27 at the Bhinneka Tunggal Ika Room on Monday (5/18). Lemhannas Distributes Qurban Meat to Over 1,000 Beneficiaries

JAKARTA - The National Resilience Institute (Lemhannas RI) marked the Islamic Day of Sacrifice, Eid al-Adha 1447 Hijriah, by slaughtering and distributing sacrificial animals at the institute's East Parking Lot on Thursday (5/28). For this year's commemoration, Lemhannas received 13 cows and eight goats, the meat of which will be distributed to more than 1,000 beneficiaries.

The Chief of the General Bureau at the Lemhannas Brigadier General of Police Gatut Kurniadin, S.I.K., S.H. who served as the person-in-charge for the 2026 Eid al-Adha event, stated that the recipients of the qurban meat included Lemhannas officials and employees, contract workers, canteen vendors, cooperative staff, office cleaners, as well as nearby residents.

Speaking on the occasion, Lemhannas Governor Ace Hasan Syadzily emphasized that Eid al-Adha is a crucial moment to strengthen devotion to God and emulate the core values of sacrifice and sincerity taught in Islam.

"We sacrifice these animals as a way to draw ourselves closer to the Almighty. In Islamic tradition, the qurban symbolizes the story of Prophet Ibrahim, who was commanded by Allah to sacrifice his son, Ismail," the governor said.



To ensure the slaughtering process met official standards, the committee engaged certified slaughtering services provided by the Cakung Slaughterhouse (RPH Cakung). The entire series

of activities was organized as a reflection of social care and the spirit of togetherness within the Lemhannas big family to share blessings with the community during the Eid al-Adha celebration.

JAKARTA - Indonesian Vice President Gibran Rakabuming Raka affirmed that strengthening food security and digital transformation are two important pillars in facing increasingly complex global challenges. This was conveyed during a briefing for participants in the Consolidation Program for National-level Leaders (P3N) Batch 27 and the Preparation and Consolidation Program for the National-level Leaders(P4N) Batch 69 of Lemhannas RI, at the Vice President's Palace on Wednesday (6/3).
